

Check List

1. Before installing the Kaseya Online Backup module on the VSA server, verify that all the necessary prerequisites have been met:
 - ✓ Verify that Kaseya Server K2 6.0.1 (or later) is installed
 - ✓ Verify that there is at least 3GB RAM on the server
 - ✓ If the VSA and the Database are running on different servers, verify that these 2 servers are time-synchronized

2. Before deploying Kaseya Online Backup on the endpoints, verify that all the necessary prerequisites have been met:
 - ✓ Verify that Client Machines are running:
 - Windows 7, XP, Windows Server 2008, 2003
 - Mac OS X: Leopard or Snow Leopard
 - ✓ Verify that there is at least 1 GB of free disk space on each client machine

3. KOB installation:
 - ✓ The first step is to install KOB on the VSA server.
 - ✓ No need to reboot.
 - ✓ The next step is to install KOB on the selected endpoints:
 - Click on the Online Backup tab in the VSA
 - Select Configure -> Install/Remove
 - Select the desired endpoints
 - Click on Install at the top of the page
 - ✓ No need to reboot.

4. Running a Backup
 - ✓ The first backup is a full backup, therefore it will take longer.
 - ✓ The subsequent backups are incremental backups, and will be much faster and smaller.
 - ✓ Perform a backup using the Backup Profiles or the File Selection on the Schedule page.
